The Cass County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 A.M. with all members present: Duane McFadden, chair; Charles Rieken, Gaylord Schelling, Frank Waters and Mark Wedemeyer. Agenda upon motion by Schelling, 2nd by Rieken was approved. Minutes of January 3, 2012 upon motion by Rieken, 2nd by Waters were approved as read.

County Attorney Daniel Feistner reviewed current legal activity.

County Conservation Director Micah Lee presented 2nd quarter report of activity at county recreational sites (Cold Springs, Cocklin Fish Farm, Hitchcock House) and naturalist's activity. City of Griswold took over management of Cocklin Fish Farm 1/1/2012.

County treasurer received request for compromise of tax on a County held tax sale certificate. Request: abate interest, penalty and costs and requestor will pay taxes owing. The mobile home would then go back on the tax roll.

Motion by Schelling, 2nd by Rieken: to enter into a compromise agreement (Code of Iowa 445.16) with Sonya Olwell to abate interest, penalty and costs of County Held Tax Sale Certificate Number 2007-102 (Mobile Home) and Olwell agrees to pay all back taxes. (payment schedule: \$50.00/month beginning January 2012). Carried unanimously.
