Gronewold, Bell, Kyhnn & Co. P.C. CPAs have released an audit report on Cass County, Iowa.

The County had local tax revenue of \$20,521,918 for the year ended June 30, 2009, which included \$1,457,523 in tax credits from the state. The County forwarded \$14,942,967 of the local tax revenue to the townships, school districts, cities and other taxing bodies in the County.

The County retained \$5,578,951 of the local tax revenue to finance County operations, a 0.4 percent increase from the prior year. Other revenues included \$4,076,438 from the state, including indirect federal funding of \$550,141, direct federal funding of \$594,548, charges for service of \$352,024, and \$197,003 for the use of money and property.

Expenditures for County operations totaled \$11,660,467, a 0.6 percent decrease from the prior year. Expenses included \$4,126,502 for roads and transportation, \$2,121,352 for mental health, \$1,710,523 for public safety and legal services, and \$1,007,030 for administrative services.
