

CASS COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TESTING FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS

Notice is hereby given: an opening for a full-time position for Cass County Deputy Sheriff is available. Testing will be done on Tuesday, April 6, 2010, at the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, Camp Dodge, 7105 N.W. 70th Street, Johnston, IA (515) 242-5357 (Photo ID Required), as follows:

- Physical Fitness Test (Cooper Test) – 9:00 a.m. (Wear appropriate attire and bring a towel and change of clothes for after the testing.) Shower facility is available afterward.
- P.O.S.T. Exam – 11:00 a.m. ILEA
- MMPI-2 Psychological Test – 1:30 p.m. Iowa Law Enforcement Academy

Anyone interested in taking the examination must file written application with the Cass County Sheriff's Office at least seven (7) days prior to examination. The application must be postmarked or personally delivered by March 29, 2010.

CURRENTLY CERTIFIED OFFICERS

Certified officers may lateral per Lateral Transfer rule. An applicant already in law enforcement can transfer without testing if they are without a break from service for not more than 180 days from law enforcement service.

APPLICANT WITH PRIOR TEST RESULTS WITHIN THE PAST CALENDAR YEAR

You will need to provide the Cass County Sheriff's Office with the date you took the test and the Sheriff's Office will obtain your POST score from Stanard & Associates. You will also need to obtain a certified copy of your physical fitness test from the location you took that test and provide that to the Cass County Sheriff's Office. If you have previously taken the tests, you may re-take them if you wish; however, your latest test scores will be the ones considered for this position.
